Application Instructions

Timeline:

Application must be received via email on or before Feb 1st, of the year applying for the fall semester at the above email address.

Notification of award: Award processing and notification will be sent on or before March 15th for classes beginning in the upcoming fall semester.

Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for a scholarship, you must:

- demonstrate financial need and this should be considered to be of utmost importance in receiving the scholarship.
- be scheduled to graduate or have graduated from high school in Grand Forks, ND, East Grand Forks, MN and Carrington, ND.
- Must have maintained an average of a 2.0 or “C” average throughout four years of high school.
- Have been accepted or are currently attending a post secondary institution.
- The student may be a person who does not have sufficient funds to enter or re-enter college, such as a military veteran, a single mother, or any other person with a hardship.

Selection Criteria:

- Financial Need
- Graduated or scheduled to graduate from high school in the Grand Forks, ND area or Carrington, ND Area.
- 80% of scholarships awarded to students from Grand Forks, ND and East Grand Forks, MN.
- 20% of scholarships awarded to students from Carrington, ND.

Required Materials to be submitted by Applicant:

- Student Application
- Nominator Form by faculty / teacher / employer
- Most current high school or college transcript

M.W.E. Scholarship Fund

Amount and Duration of Award:

- The amount of the award may be variable, and determined by the student's unmet need on the financial aid award package.
- The award is not to exceed the current amount of tuition and mandatory fees, books, room and board for that year if the student was to attend the University of North Dakota. (the student is not required to attend the University of North Dakota and may attend the college or institution of their choice).
- The award is renewable for up to 4 years of continuous undergraduate education as long as a grade point of 2.0 or "C" average is maintained and a full time course load is taken each semester.
- The scholarship funds will be sent directly to the institution of higher education.
